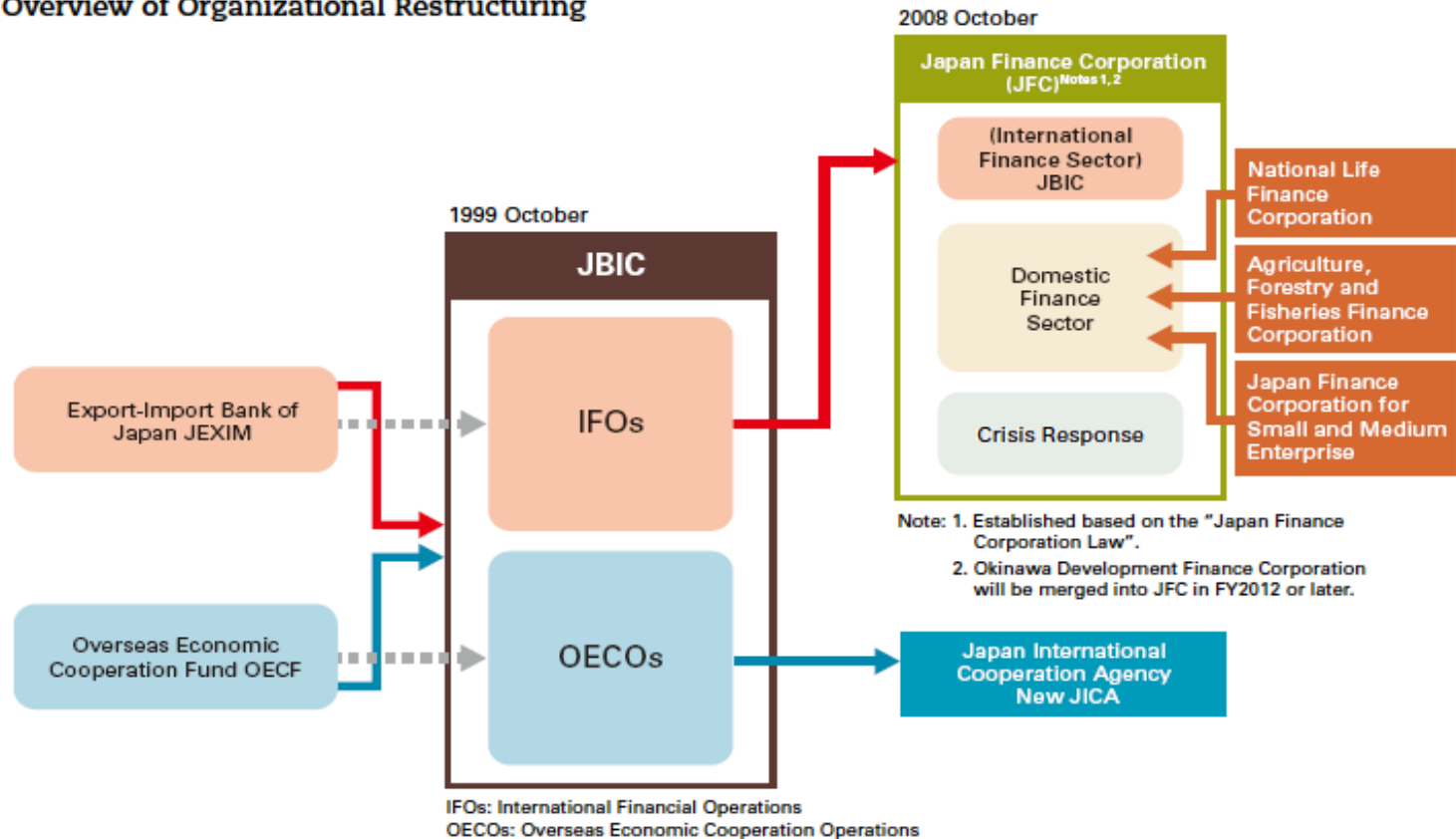

# 1. Status of JBIC

- On October 1, 2008, **International Financial Operations of Japan Bank for International Cooperation (JBIC)**, **National Life Finance Corporation (NLFC)**, **Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries Finance Corporation (AFC)** and **Japan Finance Corporation for Small and Medium Enterprise (JASME)** have merged, to become a new policy-based financing institution, **Japan Finance Corporation (JFC)**.
- Of the two types of operations conducted by JBIC, JFC will take over International Financial Operations in its international wing.
- However, to maintain international trust and confidence enjoyed by JBIC, the international wing of JFC continues to use the name of JBIC as it conducts international finance operations.

## Overview of Organizational Restructuring



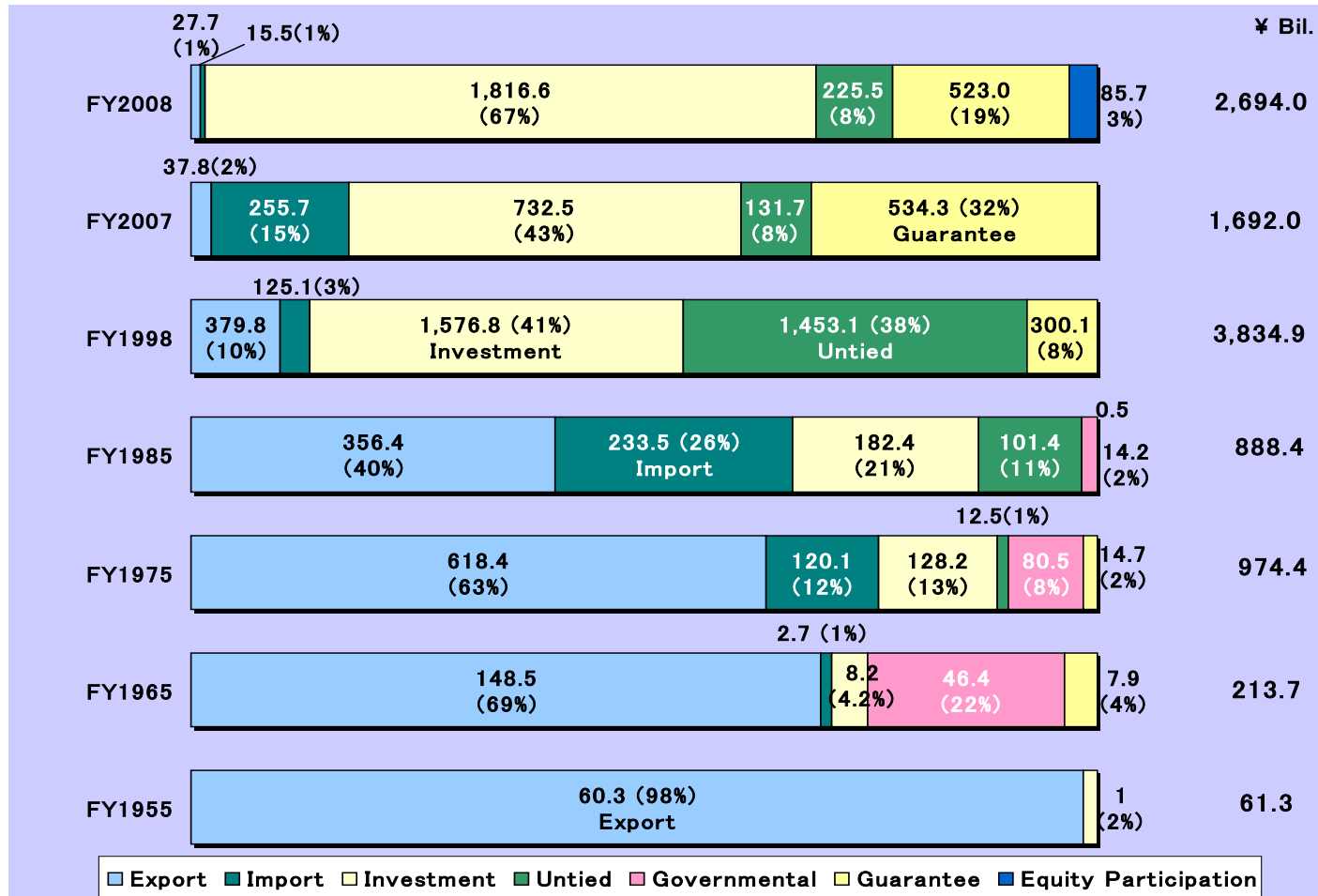
## 2. Mission

  - **Responding to disruptions in financial order in the international economy.**

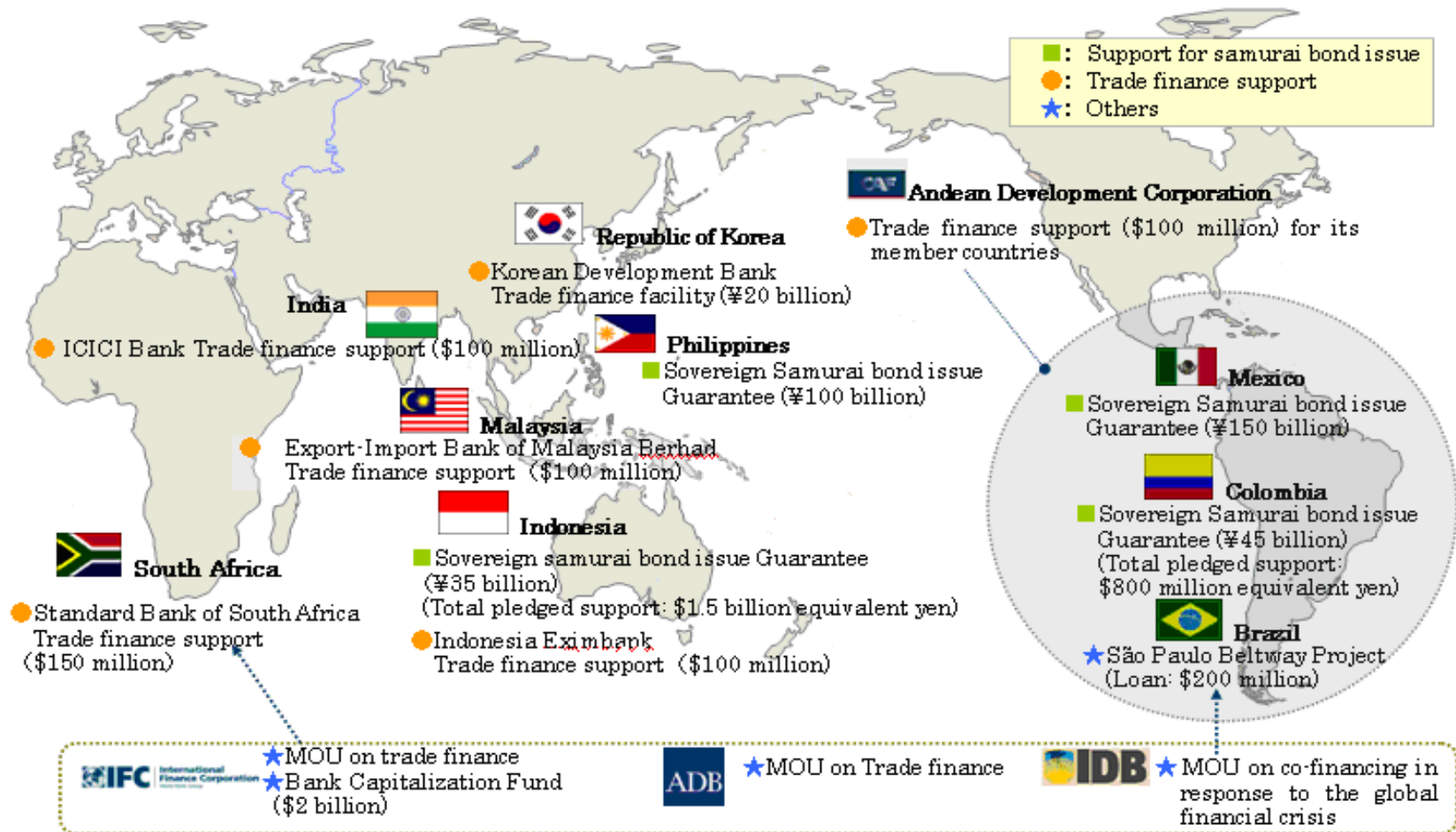
