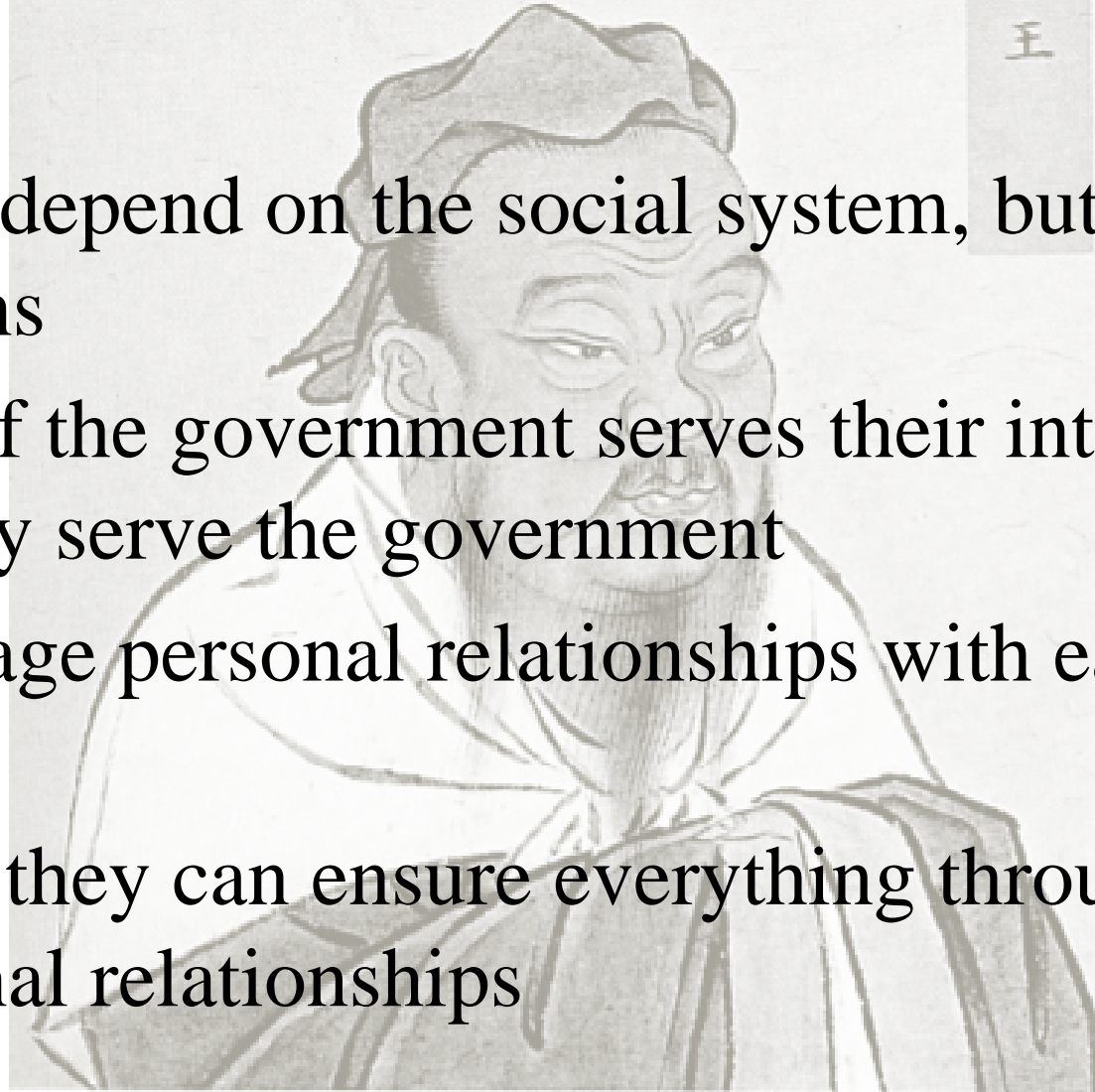

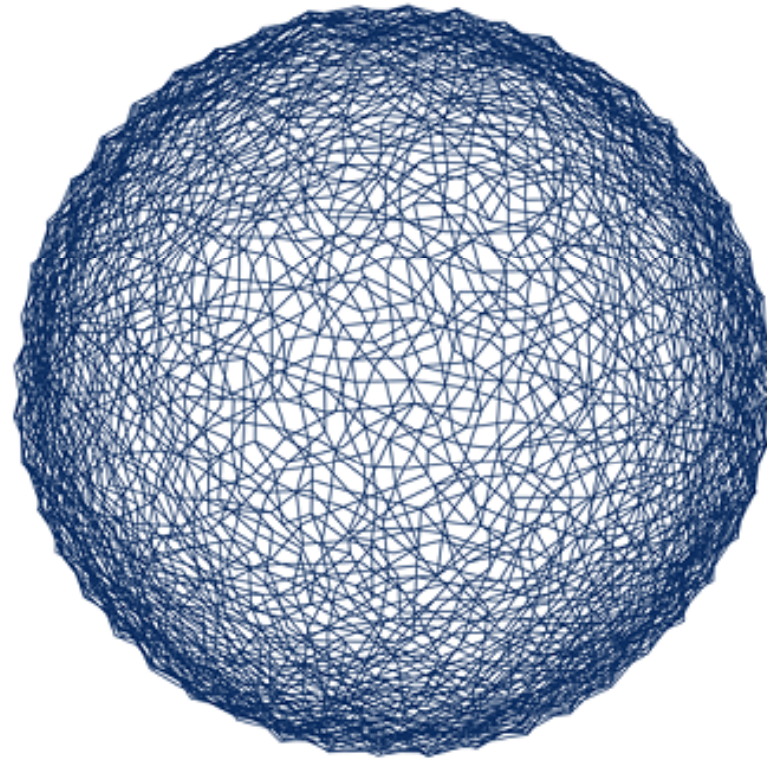


Chinese Beliefs and Priorities

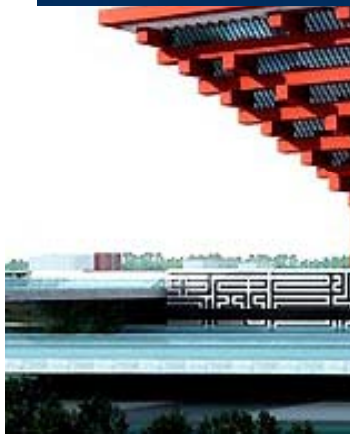
- Don't depend on the social system, but on humans

- Think they can ensure everything through personal relationships

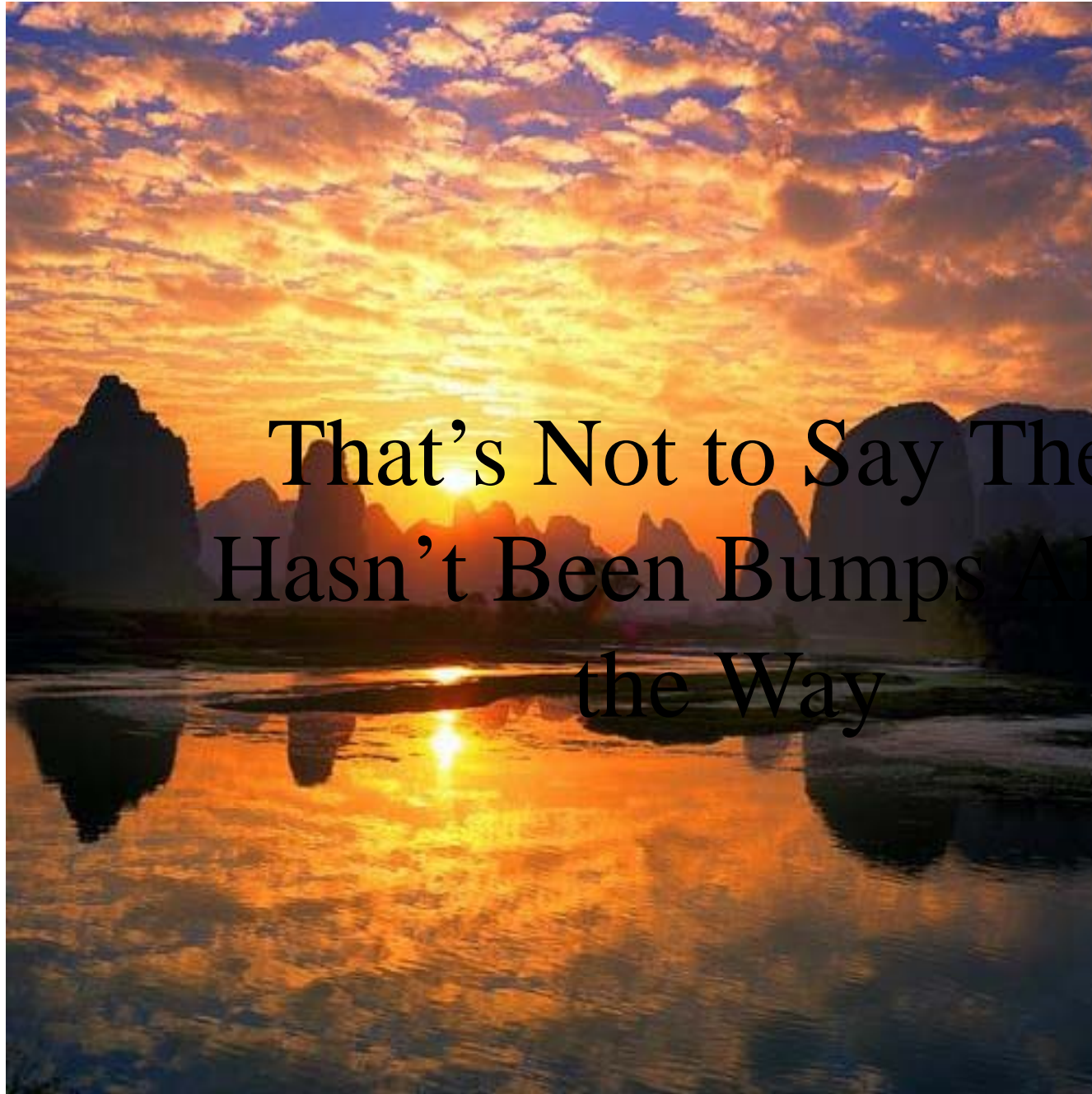

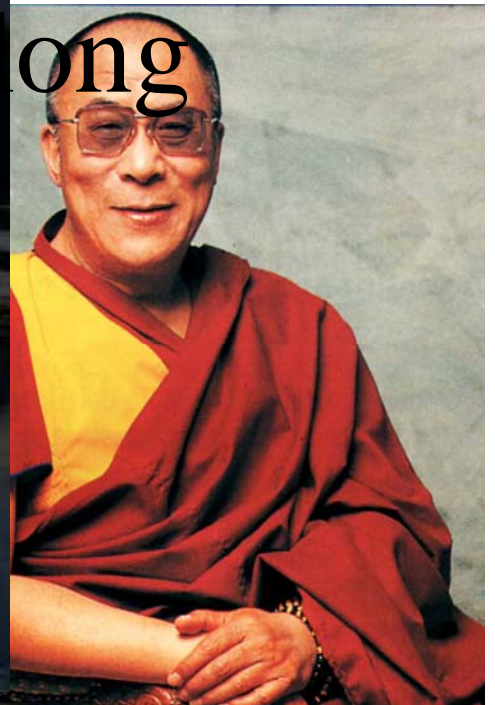

China will be a Large Dragon that will fly with the American Eagle.

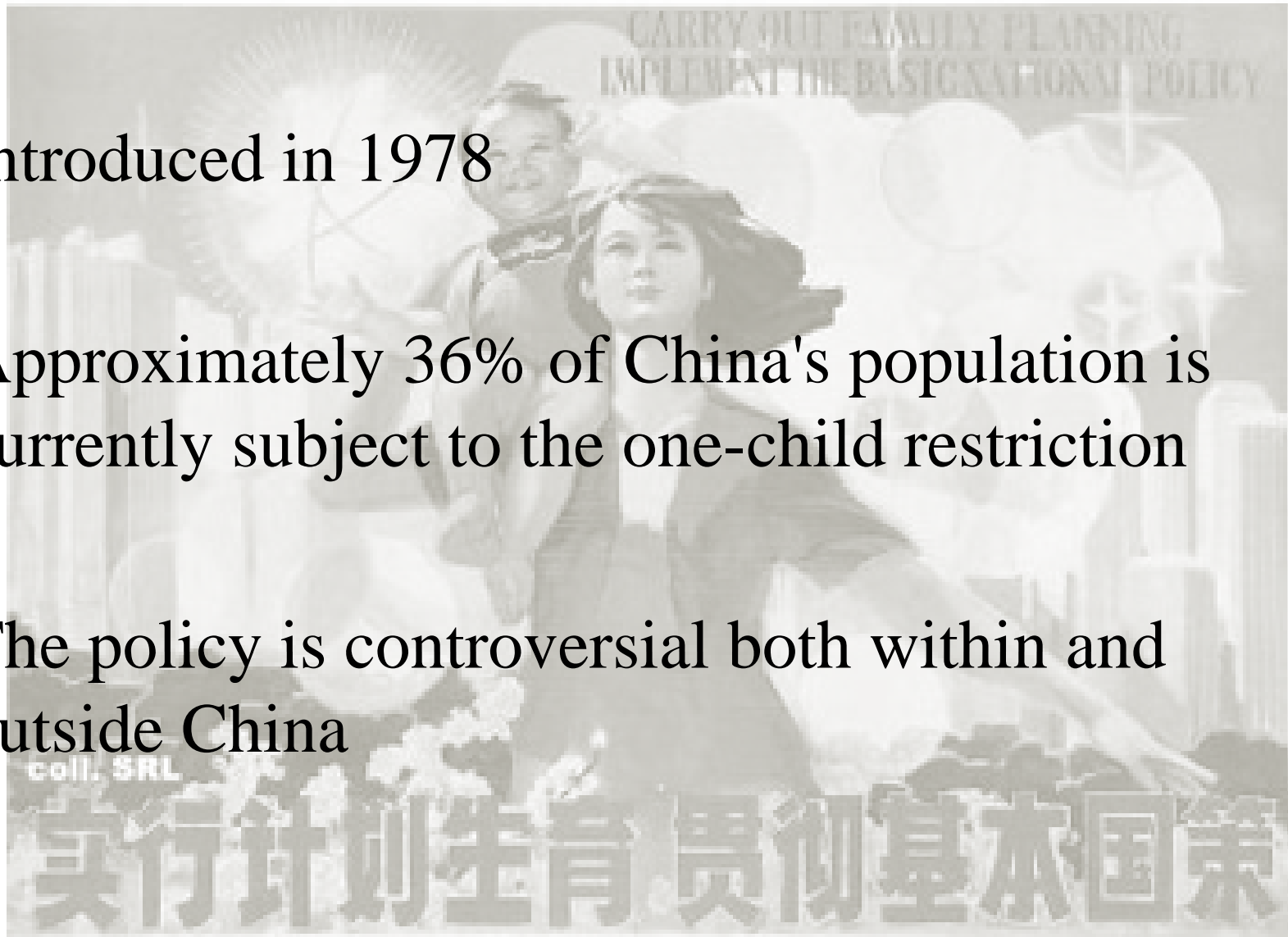

One Child Policy




- Introduced in 1978
- Approximately 36% of China's population is currently subject to the one-child restriction
- The policy is controversial both within and outside China

 - Nearly 78 million members at the end of 2009 (about 5.6% of the total population of mainland China)
